UEC

- Pass with a Grade B in three (3) subjects including Mathematics and pass in English; or

STAM

- Pass with a minimum grade of Maqbul with a credit in Mathematics and a pass in English at SPM level; or

STPM

- A pass with a minimum of Grade C (GP 2.00) in any subject with a credit in Mathematics and a pass in English at the SPM level; or

SKM (LEVEL 3, MQF) IN RELATED FIELDS

- Pass. (Candidates without Mathematics can be admitted subject to an evaluation to determine the Mathematics competency is equivalent to SPM level); or

CERTIFICATE (LEVEL 3, MQF) IN RELATED FIELDS

- Pass with a minimum CGPA of 2.00

A-LEVEL

- Pass with minimum Grade D in any two (2) subjects and a credit in Mathematics at O-Level or its equivalent; or

UEC

- Pass with at least Grade B in five (5) subjects including Mathematics subject; or

STAM

- Pass with minimum Grade of Jayyid with credit in Mathematics at SPM level; or

FOUNDATION/ MATRICULATION

- Pass with minimum CGPA of 2.50 and a credit in Mathematics at SPM level; or

DIPLOMA IN ACCOUNTING OR RELATED FIELDS (LEVEL 4, MQF)

UEC

- Pass with at least Grade B in five (5) subjects including Mathematics and English at SPM level; or

STAM

- Pass with a minimum grade of Jayyid, and credits in Mathematics and pass in English at SPM level or its equivalent; or

FOUNDATION/ MATRICULATION

- Pass with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 with a credit in Mathematics and English at SPM level or its equivalent; or

DIPLOMA IN FINANCE OR RELATED FIELD (LEVEL 4, MQF)

- Pass with a minimum CGPA of 2.50

Note:

The credit requirement for Mathematics and pass in English at SPM level can be waived should the qualifications contain Mathematics and English subjects with equivalent/higher achievement.
