

SUMMARY OF ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

3 credits in SPM (or its equivalent in 5 subjects for international students) in Bahasa Melayu (Malaysians only), Mathematics, any Science subject + 2* other subjects; or, *3 other subjects for international students

Pass with 5 credits including Bahasa Melayu, Mathematics and Science. Students are required to take Bahasa Kebangsaan A in any semester

Grade B in 3 subjects, including Bahasa Melayu, Mathematics, and Science; or

- Registered with Nursing Board and has a current Annual Practicing Certificate
- 3 years of clinical working experience

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS
