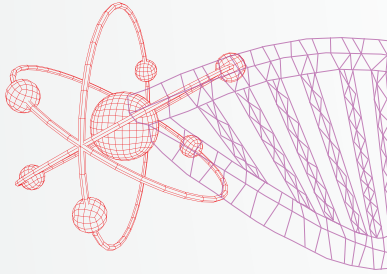

SUMMARY OF ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

SPM or its equivalent	• 3 credits in SPM (or its equivalent in 5 subjects for international students) in Bahasa Melayu (Malaysians only), Mathematics, any Science subject + 2* other subjects; or, *3 other subjects for international students
O-Level	• Pass with 5 credits including Bahasa Melayu, Mathematics and Science. Students are required to take Bahasa Kebangsaan A in any semester
Unified Examination Certificate (UEC)	• Grade B in 3 subjects, including Bahasa Melayu, Mathematics, and Science; or
Assistant Nurse Certificate / Community Nurse Certificate	• Pass SPM • Registered with Nursing Board and has a current Annual Practicing Certificate • 3 years of clinical working experience
